Dear Assistant Secretary Henshaw:


I hope you will give Steven P. Miller full consideration for the OSHA Crane and Derrick Negotiated Rulemaking Advisory Committee (C-DAC) that will develop new rules for construction cranes and derrick safety.

Although I do not know him personally, I am aware of Mr. Miller's experience. As the President of Miller Safety Consulting, Inc., Mr. Miller has trained many people on the proper use of cranes and derricks. Safety is paramount in construction, and I believe his experience in construction safety consulting would be an asset to the C-DAC. He also has the support of the Steel Erectors Safety Association of Colorado, an organization made up of a mixture of union and non-union members working together to improve safety in their industry.
