

Revision of Subpart N for cranes and derricks

- We are very pleased to see that there will be a new committee and that we will be able to use technology introduced since the last subpart N.
- We recommend the broadening of the representation of the group to distinguish between manufacturer/assemblers and the manufacturers of equipment used under the hook, used to refine control, used to increase warnings to those in the vicinity, used to pick more or handle less, used to detect hazards, etc.
- The introduction in 1997 of the insulating link, Load Insulator[®], will prevent the main cause of construction crane fatalities as defined by OSHA.
- We believe that the World's leading authority on Insulating links (and expert on crane scales/load measurement), Hugh Pratt, would be a useful servant to the committee. We request his inclusion in the committee.
