As a nominee for the Negotiated Rulemaking Committee – C-DAC, I feel compelled to respectfully offer my comments regarding your selection process.

First and foremost I commend you on your efforts and on what appears to be a good group.

I do ask that you consider my nomination for the following reasons:

1. I have pledged to represent SC&RA not my own company. I feel strongly that the validity of this process is weakened if the prime crane owners association is not represented on the committee.
2. I offer the viewpoint of a small business, hands-on business owner, which is the make up of the majority of the SC&RA members. At present I do not believe this perspective is adequately covered on the committee.
3. I have actively participated in a positive way for the last four (4) years on the ACCSH Subpart "N" workgroup.
