The report may be of relevance to your upcoming committee discussion.

The Fatality Assessment and Control Evaluation (FACE) project, a cooperative agreement between the New York State Department of Health and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health, studies traumatic work-related fatalities and collects information on the factors that lead to fatal injuries in the workplace. Based on on-site evaluations, New York State FACE staff develop recommendations for prevention of future injuries. These recommendations are distributed to employers, workers, and other organizations interested in promoting workplace safety.
