TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I AM THE PRESIDENT OF WHITE BROTHERS TRUCKING CO. AND AM WRITING THIS LETTER IN SUPPORT OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR'S USE OF THE NEGOTIATING RULEMAKING PROCESS IN DEVELOPING NEW REGULATIONS AND SPECIFICALLY THE DRAFT DOCUMENT FOR A NEW PROPOSED RULE UNDER SUBPART N.

SINCE 1970, CFR 1926.550 HAS HAD MINOR CHANGES AND IS LONG OVERDUE FOR A REWRITE TO REFLECT CURRENT PRACTICES GOVERNING LIFTING EQUIPMENT IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY.

I HAVE REVIEWED THE PROPOSED RULE FOR SUBPART N AND SUPPORT THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE C-DAC NEGOTIATING RULEMAKING COMMITTEE. I FEEL THAT THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY HAS BEEN REPRESENTED WELL UNDER THIS PROCESS AND CONSTRUCTION SITES NATIONWIDE WILL BE MUCH SAFER IN THE FUTURE WHEN THE DRAFT DOCUMENT BECOMES A FINAL RULE.
