


To whom it may concern:

I am the President of Caribbean Crane Inspection and Certification Bureau, Inc., and I am writing this letter in support of the U.S. Department of Labor's use of the negotiating rulemaking process in developing new regulations and specifically the draft document for a new proposed rule under Subpart N.

Since 1970, CFR 1926.550 has had minor changes and is long overdue for a rewrite to reflect current practices governing lifting equipment in the construction industry.
